

BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS

IF YOU AND YOUR GROUP ARE FULLY VACCINATED, THEN YOU ONLY HAVE 1 DAY OF QUARANTINE AND A NEGATIVE RESULT FROM DAY 0 TEST MEANS YOU ARE FREE TO EXPLORE THE ISLANDS. (Unvaccinated children 5-17 years have the same privileges with the group, but must have an additional Day 4 test too).

IF YOU ARE ONLY PARTIALLY VACCINATED (1 DOSE ADMINISTERED OF TWO) THEN YOU MUST QUARANTINE FOR 4 DAYS AS INDICATED BY THE BVI GOVERNMENT. THIS IS A SAMPLE ITINERARY FOR YOUR FIRST 4 DAYS OF QUARANTINE AFTER ARRIVAL TO HORIZON YACHT CHARTERS, NANNY CAY MARINA

We know that these are challenging times for travel, but our charter guests that have been sailing with us in the British Virgin Islands since our borders opened last December, have all agreed that they have had the best time ever. The BVI is as beautiful as always, and we, at Horizon Yacht Charters, think it is even more so with little traffic to all the popular sites, like The Baths at Virgin Gorda. Can you imagine being the only ones there? This can be your experience too!

We have put together a sample itinerary for your first few days of Quarantine on board your yacht below, so that you can see what fun and freedom you can enjoy while remaining isolated from everyone until you receive your negative Day 4 PCR test result. Remember to be very conservative on your water usage as you cannot top off your tanks until day 5 or 6. Various restaurants will deliver ice to you as well as your meals and cocktails, so take advantage of them to stock up your coolers on board.

Day 0 – PCR test on arrival, and you are transported to your yacht at Nanny Cay Marina. Please note that from March 25th transportation is not included in the Government's processing fees, and Horizon will organize our Gold Seal Approved taxi to transport you to your yacht with advance arrival notice. If it is not too late in the day, throw off your lines and go sailing! Our wonderful staff at Horizon will assist you. Sail to your first night's anchorage to Great Harbour, Peter Island and pick up a mooring ball. Plan on dining aboard or order in. Oceans 7 Beach Club is open 1pm to 9pm Friday, Saturday and Sunday and they will deliver ice, food, and cocktails to your yacht during these hours. Please call in your order and credit card to 284 340-1177 or 284 340 1117.

On your first night you can also anchor in Little Harbour, Peter Island and if sea conditions are good, Deadman's Bay, Peter Island.

If you prefer, sleep aboard the yacht at our docks if there is not enough time to head out. Your yacht will be fully provisioned, with all your permits and paperwork done in advance, as well as your Virtual Boat and Chart Briefings done well before your arrival. You might like to order dinner for delivery from Peg Leg's Restaurant while on the dock, and a great breakfast with good coffee from Island Roots in the morning for delivery, before you leave the dock. Menus are left aboard. We are here to help with any last-minute questions from the dock.

Day 1 – wake up to a beautiful anchorage, go snorkeling and have some fun in the ocean, staying within a 30ft radius of your yacht. Or GO SAILING and drop anchor at the stunning Deadman's Bay, Peter Island for a lunch time stop. You will receive your arrival test result during the latter part of the

day and assuming it is negative you are then free to explore 17 different anchorages (some of which are daytime only) throughout the BVI.

Sail to Benure's Bay, Norman Island where you can pick up a mooring ball (you need \$30 cash ready in a plastic bag to hand over to the fee collector in his dinghy), enjoy sundowners while watching a spectacular sunset and spend the night in yet another idyllic spot.

Day 2 – snorkel the reefs and explore the beautiful Benure's Bay in the morning or paddle or kayak from the boat (remember to order these in advance). Sail to the most amazing beach on Peter Island – White Bay – and drop anchor. Here you can swim ashore or dinghy ashore to the deserted beach (so long as there is no wave action) and enjoy some beach time in your own company. Remember no socializing ashore allowed. There is a beautiful snorkelling reef to the North of the bay. We do not recommend staying here overnight as it is bad holding ground and can sometimes kick up a swell, so sail to Soldier's Bay, Norman Island and pick up a mooring ball.

If you do not want to cook tonight, call Pirates Bight on 284 443 1305 or VHF 16 and order a takeaway meal and cocktails. They also deliver ice. Open 7 days a week from, 11.30am. Credit card paid in advance over the phone, contactless delivery to your yacht.

Day 3 – sail over to Jost Van Dyke, being careful not to encroach on USVI waters. The border line is clearly marked on charts and GPS Chart Plotters. Sail to Manchioneel Bay as shown on your anchorages chart near Little Jost Van Dyke where you will drop anchor in the sand only. Do take note of the weather and swell at this location. Swim and snorkel and enjoy the small beach in the area. The B-Line Beach Bar is nearby and will deliver ice and meals to your yacht with a few hours prior notice. Call 284 344 2304 to see what they have available on the menu and set up a delivery every day of the week.

On Day 3 you should receive an email or call from the BVI Health Services to set up your Day 4 PCR test, so please request the clinic at Jost Van Dyke as your preferred location.

Day 4 – get up early and sail to Great Harbour, Jost Van Dyke (not too far away) and pick up a mooring ball. This is the time for your Day 4 PCR test which can be done at the clinic behind the Police Station in the harbour. Usually, the tests are done between 8am and 8.30am so the tests can be sent over to Tortola on the 9am ferry for analysis. Please remember to always wear your mask while ashore, and hand sanitise on entry to the testing site And no socializing or visiting any establishments at this stage. Return to your yacht and continue with the fun and go sailing! Sail up to George Dog for a lunchtime stop and snorkel, and resume the sail up to North Sound, aiming to overnight in Malone Bay (near Leverick Bay) for your last night of Quarantine.

Day 5 – go sailing while you are awaiting your test results. Your results can take around 24-30 hours to be notified to you depending on volume of visitors at the time, so if you set sail for Anegada by the time you reach there, you should know your results. A negative result means total freedom So, pick up a mooring ball outside Anegada Reef Hotel, go ashore and have a celebratory cocktail and fabulous lobster dinner!

Enjoy the rest of the BVI and dine ashore or visit the bars wherever you wish for the remainder of your charter. Soggy Dollar, Willy T and all the other iconic places are yours to visit from now on! BVI

This is just a sample itinerary and can be modified to suit your requirements, but this gives you an idea of the amount of sailing, swimming, snorkeling, and beachcombing you can enjoy while in your Quarantine period.
